Mr. George Lazaro, Fulcrum Consulting Services procured to assist with application for the EPA. Out of the \$2 billion only \$335 million allocated, we are able to apply for \$20 million on climate change. County has gone through the process to apply and plan activities. Ben Bolt-Green Acres area Colonia concept many mobile homes, replace windows, appliances with high energy, roofing, solar panels and need to address drainage issues. This program to include resiliency center to be located at the fairgrounds up to 5,000 square feet. Also, utilized as an emergency center, training center, most importantly for low-income citizens to come in for cooling center and warming center. Designed within the green concept and named the various ways, help also as a post disaster. Final component will be water line construction for growth.

County Judge, Trevino stated on the emergency management to continue to stage all their equipment, in the facility would have restrooms, showers and rooms. We are second tier away from the water-Gulf of Mexico. Purchase of additional property west of Merchant's building to create four entrances and exits on both sides for safety and security. Economic Development for our tax base on installing this waterline, this grant is no match. Meet with the City of Alice and have 100% support, REAL building a new facility off 1554, creating a loop.

Waylon Oaks, City of Alice spoke on the 12" waterline off Hwy 44 and 281 off County Road 117. The higher demand of water on Northside and new infrastructure possibly in 10-15 years additional water tower.
