WHEREAS, Coach Guerra has been honored as a 2016 Distinguished Alumnus of Texas A&I University, recognizing his professional excellence, community service, and unwavering dedication to youth development; and WHEREAS, he remains a proud and humble advocate for higher education and public service, always wearing his signature camouflage A&I cap—a symbol of gratitude to the university that gave him a chance when others would not; and

RESOLUTION 2025-0714-2 Resolution Regarding Civil Rights

Jim Wells County, Texas

Whereas, Jim Wells County, Texas, (hereinafter referred to as "Jim Wells County") has been awarded a Community Development Block Grant – Mitigation Program (CDBG-MIT) grant from the Texas General Land Office (hereinafter referred to as "GLO");

Whereas, Jim Wells County, in accordance with Section 109 of the Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act. (24 CFR 6); the Age Discrimination Act of 1975 (42 U.S.C. 6101-6107); and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. 794) and for construction contracts greater than \$10,000, must take actions to ensure that no person or group is denied benefits such as employment, training, housing, and contracts generated by the CDBG-MIT activity, on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, or disability;

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PREMONT, TEXAS AND JIM WELLS COUNTY, TEXAS REGARDING THE "COWBOY SIGN" LOCATED ON JIM WELLS COUNTY PARK PROPERTY

RECITALS

- WHEREAS, a sign commonly known as the "Cowboy Sign" ("Sign") has been in place and
 in existence on the southeast corner of Jim Wells County Park property located in
 Precinct No. 4 since approximately 1966;
- WHEREAS, although a prior written agreement between the City and County regarding the placement and operation of the Sign may have existed, such agreement can no longer be located in the official records of either entity;
- WHEREAS, the parties wish to execute this new Interlocal Agreement in order to memorialize and clarify their respective rights and responsibilities related to the placement and operation of the Sign going forward;
- WHEREAS, this Agreement is made for the mutual benefit of the citizens of Jim Wells
 County and specifically the residents of the City of Premont, and the Sign serves as both
 a source of civic pride and a method of communicating public announcements and
 information;
- NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

SECTION 1. AUTHORITY

This Agreement is made pursuant to and in accordance with the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, and other applicable law.

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Agreement is to authorize the City to continue to maintain, operate, and use the Cowboy Sign on County park property for public and municipal purposes, under the terms and conditions set forth herein.

SECTION 3. TERM

This Agreement shall be effective as of the date of final signature and shall remain in effect for a term of 25 years, with successive 25 year extensions unless either party provides written notice of termination to the other party at any time during the last 6 months of the existing term.

SECTION 4. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

4.1. Use of Property.

Jim Wells County hereby grants permission to the City of Premont to use the designated portion being the southeast corner of the Jim Wells County Park property for the placement, maintenance, and operation of the Cowboy Sign.

4.2. Maintenance and Costs.

All costs associated with the installation, operation, repair, replacement, or removal of the Sign, including utilities, if any, shall be the sole responsibility of the City of Premont.

4.3. Compliance with Law.

The City agrees to maintain the Sign in good working condition and in compliance with all applicable laws, codes, and ordinances.

SECTION 5. INDEMNIFICATION

To the extent permitted by law, the City of Premont agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Jim Wells County, its officials, agents, and employees from any and all claims, liabilities, damages, and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of or in connection with the City's placement, operation, or maintenance of the Sign on County property.

SECTION 6. TERMINATION

Upon termination, the City shall promptly remove the Sign and restore the property to its original condition.

SECTION 7. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement represents the entire understanding between the parties regarding the subject matter and supersedes any prior agreements or understandings, whether written or oral.

SECTION 8. AMENDMENT

This Agreement may be amended only by a written document approved and executed by both parties.

SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY

If any part, portion, clause, or paragraph in the agreement is deemed to be invalid, the remainder of the agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 10. EXECUTION

This Agreement may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of which shall constitute one and the same instrument.

INTERGOVERMENTAL AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN BROOKS COUNTY AND JIM WELLS COUNTY FOR THE JAILING OF PRISONERS

This Interlocal Agreement (hereinafter "AGREEMENT") is made by and entered in duplicate originals, between, Brooks County, Texas (hereinafter "Brooks County") a county duly created and organized under the constitution and laws of Texas acting through is Commissioners' Court, and Jim Wells County, Texas (hereinafter "Jim Wells") a county duly created and organized under the constitution and laws of Texas acting through it Commissioners' Court, together the "PARTIES" on the date indicated below. Texas acting through its Commissioners' Court, together the "PARTIES" on the date indicated below.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the functions and services specified in this AGREEMENT are governmental functions or services that either party to the contract is authorized to perform individually; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article V, section 18 of the Tx. Const.Ch 351 of the Tx Local Govt. Code Ch 791 of the Tx Govt. Code, and other statutory authority, in the public interest Brooks County may execute and implement interlocal government agreements with an adjoining county for the jailing of prisoners of other counties; and

WHEREAS, Jim Wells County needs assistance for the jailing and care of arrested and incarcerated individuals; and

WHEREAS, Brooks County has a jail located in Falfurrias, City, Brooks County, Texas with capacity, ability, and resources to provide assistance to jail and care for such inmates; and

WHEREAS, the PARTIES desire to enter into an agreement in which Brooks County will provide housing and care for certain inmates arrested or incarcerated by Jim Wells County; and

WHEREAS, the PARTIES have authorized their respective representatives to enter and sign this AGREEMENT.

DETENTION SERVICE

Brooks County shall provide the following necessary and appropriate services for Jim Wells County to the maximum extent authorized by AGREEMENT without regards to race, religion, color, age, sex, and national origin, as follows:

1.01 Facilities

Jim Wells County warrants that all facilities provided for the detention of inmates shall meet the requirements of the Texas Commission on Jail Standards (hereafter as per TCJS).

1.02 HOUSING AND THE CARE OF INMATES

If space is available, Brooks County agrees to jail, and provide secure custody, care, safekeeping, meals, and routine and/or emergency medical services to inmate(s) as set out by TCJS, Brooks County shall apply the TCJS concerning the separation and categories of inmates.

1.03 MEDICAL SERVICES

The periderm rate contained within this AGREEMENT provides for only routine medical services performed in the jail as on-site sick staff with non-prescription over the counter/non-legend and routine drug and medical supplies.

In-house nonprescriptive medication will be administered upon inmate requests and such medication will be charged to the inmate. If an inmate is indigent, they will not be refused medication or services.

The per diem does not cover medical / healthcare services provided outside of Brooks County Jail.

Jim Wells County shall be responsible for medical / healthcare services cost incurred by inmates outside of Brooks County Jail.

1.04 MEDICAL INFORMATION

When available, Jim Wells County shall provide Brooks County with any medical information they may have concerned the inmate upon booking. Brooks County agrees to contact Jim Wells County within 10 hours of any injury incurred by a Jim Wells County inmate and provide copies of all incident reports relating to the inmate. Brooks County has been furnished with an acceptable medical release certifying the inmate can be jailed.

1.05 TRANSPORTATION

Jim Wells County shall be solely responsible for the transportation of each inmate(s) into Brooks County Jail.

1.06 SPECIAL PROGRAMS

This agreement does not include compensation for inmate education, vocational or other programs.

FINANCIAL PROVISIONS

2.01 PER DIEM RATE and BILLING PROCEDURES

The per diem rate to be paid by Jim Wells County for the jailing services under this AGREEMENT is \$65.00 per day per inmate, Jim Wells County will not be charged the day the inmate is booked but will be charged the day the inmate is released.

Documented invoices will be submitted to Jim Wells Sheriff's Office at 300 N Cameron St. Alice, Texas 78332. All documented invoices shall state the inmate(s) name and date(s) jailed.

Jim Wells County shall make payment to Brooks County Sheriff's Office at 701 East Rice, Falfurrias, Texas 78355, within 30 days of receiving documented invoices.

3.01 TERM AND TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT

This agreement is for a term of twelve (12) months from an effective date. This AGREEMENT may be renewed annually by mutual agreement of the PARTIES.

This AGREEMENT may be terminated by either PARTY upon sixty (60) days within notice in advance of the desired date of termination. This agreement may also terminate if Brooks County Jail does not function under TCJS.

4.01 INMATE SENTENCES

Brooks County shall not be responsible for the computation or processing of inmates, time of confinement, including, but not limited to, computation of good time awards / credits and discharged dates. All such computations and record keeping shall continue to be the responsibility of Jim Wells County.

Jim Wells County accepts all responsibility for the calculation and determination set forth above and for giving Brooks County notice of the same.

Jim Wells County is responsible for all paperwork, arrangements, and transportation for inmate(s) to be transferred to the TEXAS DEPARTMENT of CRIMINAL JUSTICE, Correctional Institutional Division.

5.01 LIABILITY

Brooks County agrees to and accepts full responsibility for the acts, negligence and / or omission of all Brooks County employees, laborers, agents and for those other persons doing work under a contract or agreement with Brooks County.

6.01 MISCELLANEOUS

Nature of Agreement

This agreement is contractual and is binding upon the PARTIES hereto and their successors, assigns and representatives.

Partnership / Join Venue

Nothing herein shall in any way be constructed or intended to create a partnership or joint venture between the PARTIES or to create the relationship of principal and agent between or among the PARTIES hereto shall hold itself out in a manner contrary to the terms of this paragraph.

Entire Contract / Amendments
