Ruben Villarreal, District Director for Congresswoman, Monica De La Cruz reported on what the Congresswoman is currently working on in Washington DC. He stated that congresswomen is very determined to represent Jim Wells County as best as she possibly can. He mentioned a couple of things that are pertinent to the entire South Texas region in that she worked with Secretary Rollins to secure \$750,000,000.00 in USDA investment to combat the new world screw worm. These funds to be used to revamp that operation because northern Mexico is seeing screw worm again and she and Secretary Rollins are determined to make sure it stops there. Another thing to mention is water. She has worked very closely with Secretary Rollins and the President to work on the 1944 water treaty to make sure that Mexico pays the allotment amount of money. She's trying to add that to the USC USCMA. He was very proud to announce that he and his team have recovered over \$12,000,000.00 in a little less than two years. This is money that belongs to the taxpayer that they make sure goes back to the taxpayer. He stated that anyone with any questions may call his district office in McAllen, Texas and they will be connected to him immediately.

Judge Pedro Trevino, Jr., asked that Mr. Villarreal let Congresswoman know that we send our best wishes and that we appreciate her.

County Judge, Pedro Trevino, Jr., announced that he filed for a USDA Grant. He did receive a report stating that Jim Wells County was awarded the maximum \$500,000.00 for Jim Wells County Innovation and Growth. Funds still need to be secured and will be used for remodeling of the 3rd and 4th floors of the bank building at 601 Main St.

On September 3, 2025, we had our budget workshop and on September 5, 2025, we had our second workshop. Expenditure was increased by \$324,000.00. Through budget workshops we approved a 5% pay increase. Based on the proposed tax rate of .767802, that \$23,352.324.00 and our expenses are \$24,265,633.27 that being in the general fund. That makes it a negative budget by \$913,309.27.

The tax revenue from the same to be allocated in the following basis, 60.8506 cents of said 76.7802 cents of the county general fund will to the county general fund and .599346 for maintenance operation and 0.9160 for debt service and 5.6572 cents to the special

road fund and maintenance and operation and the remaining 1.03257 cents of said 767802 cents per \$100 valuation to the flood and lateral road fund for maintenance and operation for a total tax rate of .767802 per \$100 valuation. This tax rate will raise more taxes for maintenance and operation than last year's tax rate. The above order being read, it is moved and seconded and same has passed. Thereupon, the question being called for are the following members. Each member has been given the opportunity to vote. Every member voted "yes" and we do not have any members that are not present. On this day, the 26th day of September 2025, we will approve this. We have a motion and a second and it is unanimous that this motion has been approved."

County Auditor, Cindy Garcia reported that the Sales Tax Report shows a total of general and road and bridge combined is at \$2,265,011.56 which puts Jim Wells County at 67.5% collections to date, indicating we are on track with the revenues on the sales tax as far as what was estimated. For the month of August, we are currently at an increase of 8.25 compared to last month, City of Alice had an increase of 7.35, City of Orange Grove had an increase of 16.71% and the City of Premont had an increase of 6.4% over last month. Overall, it was a good month in sales tax. In total we are in the positive of \$51,000.00 more than where we were sitting last year.

Auditors report the general fund is at 92% collection and the road and bridges are at 90%. The total revenue collection is 94%. Expenditures and road and bridges have a target of 67% and as a total we are at 66%. Total expenditure is at 67% leaving a 0% variance.
